<i>The Field Instructor</i>			
What are the requirements to become a Field Instructor?	A BSW Field Instructor must have either a BSW and two years of work experience since earning that degree, or an MSSW.	An MSSW Field Instructor must have an MSSW and two years work experience since earning that degree.	
How can one apply to become a Field Instructor?	1. Simply visit www.myinterfase.com/utssw-field/employer , click on "Click here to Register" and follow the directions to apply 2. Email the Office of Field Education (OFE) a copy of your resume at ssw-field@austin.utexas.edu 3. Wait for a welcome email from the OFE 4. Attend either of the free, 3-hour field instructor trainings: online or in-person		
What commitments does the Field Instructor have to make in order to host a student intern?	Field Instructors orient and train interns to the responsibilities of the agency. Each intern must receive at least one hour per week of face-to-face, one-on-one supervision , with his/her approved Field Instructor each week. Full block students receive one additional hour of supervision per week. We also require that the Field Instructor meet with the Clinical Faculty Liaison and the student intern during the internship to evaluate student performance.
