## LBSW/LMSW Step by Step Guide to Licensure in Texas

- Apply for exam preapproval with **BHEC**, *the Texas Behavioral Health Council*. Go to <a href="https://www.aswb.org/texas/">https://www.aswb.org/texas/</a> and click on "Apply for Exam Preapproval Now." *This will cost you \$60*.
- After receiving confirmation from BHEC, register to take the exam with **ASWB**, **Association of Social Work Boards**. Go to <a href="https://www.aswb.org/texas">https://www.aswb.org/texas</a> and click on "Register for Social Work Licensing Exam". This will cost you \$230. This is a four-hour exam with 170 multiple choice questions.
  - \*\*\*This step requires you to ask your advisor to send a letter to ASWB verifying that you are eligible to sit for the exam early (prior to graduation). You may sit for the exam in your last semester if you are graduating in May, you may start the process January 1; if you are graduating in August, you may start the process June 1.

ASWB sends you an email confirming your registration to take the exam, as well as information on how to schedule your exam at a **Pearson VUE testing site**.

## \*\*\*Steps 1-3 can be completed prior to graduation. Steps 4 and 5 can only be completed after graduation. \*\*\*

After taking and passing the exam, you may start the process with BHEC on the day you officially graduate. Under *Applications for Licensure*, click *Licensed Baccalaureate Social Worker*, *Application for* LBSW, or *Licensed Master Social Worker*, *Application for* LMSW

or both applications, you must submit the following through an online portal:
Application for licensure - Form A
Copy of Government-issued Photo Identification
<b>Submit fee</b> (\$109.00) If you're a veteran, submit a copy of your DD214 to get fee voided and oplication expedited.
Official college transcript verifying BSW or MSW from a CSWE accredited program (Please neck with your advisor as to the date your degree will be conferred on your transcript.)
Proof of completion of Jurisprudence Exam (You will also have to apply for the Jurisprudence kam. This is a \$39, 126 questions, no fail exam that you take online. All new applicants for licensing that take this exam to get their license! Go to the following website:  https://www.bhec.texas.gov/texas-state-board-of-social-worker-examiners/jurisprudence-camination/index.html
NPBD Self-Query Report - Checks if the information you put in to your self-query with the ational Practitioner Data Bank matches what they already have on file. Go here: <a href="mailto:ttps://www.npdb.hrsa.gov/pract/selfQueryBasics.jsp">ttps://www.npdb.hrsa.gov/pract/selfQueryBasics.jsp</a>
<b>Verification of Licensure in Other Jurisdiction - Form II</b> (if previously licensed in another irisdiction)
<b>Examination Security Information Form – Form VII</b> (this form essentially states that you are of taking the exam for someone else)
Social Work Employment History Form – Form I
fter the application is received, you will be given instructions on how to submit fingerprints for a ackground check. There will be a \$50 fee.
