What commitments does the Field Instructor have to make in order to host a student intern?	Field Instructors <b>orient and train</b> interns to the responsibilities of the agency. Each intern must receive at least <b>one hour per week</b> of face-to-face, one-on-one <b>supervision</b> , with his/her approved Field Instructor each week. Full block students receive one additional hour of supervision per week. We also require that the Field Instructor meet with the Clinical Faculty Liaison and the student intern during the internship to evaluate student performance.
